

**SPECIAL OPEN MEETING MINUTES HELD BY

OF THE VILLAGE OF RIVERVIEW, ST. LOUIS COUNTY, MISSOURI,  
HELD ON December 9, 2019 10:00 A.M.**

**BE IT REMEMBERED THAT** the Board of Trustees of the Village of Riverview, St. Louis County, Missouri, met at City Hall, 9699 Lilac Drive at 10:00 a.m. on December 9, 2019.

At the time and place upon roll being called, there were found to be present the following named officers and members of the Board:

Chief Jeff Dominguez gave an overview of the budget. Trustee Phyllis Paro asked if we could use any left-over money from year to year. He explained it could be used from year to year. He also discussed the purchase of a new police vehicle and a new street department vehicle. Both are already in the budget for 2020. Chief Dominguez also discussed how we would pay for the vehicles. He explained that we could use the capital improvement reimbursement money to purchase a vehicle. Further discussion about vehicles. Trustee Patricia asked if signs were in the budget. Chief Dominguez explained that they were. She also asked if he was planning on hiring another police officer. He explained they will be hiring, and the money is already in the budget for it. Further discussion on topic. Trustee Patricia Lewis brought up information from a closed personnel meeting and the other Trustees explained that she could not talk about it because it was from a closed meeting. Trustees also discussed getting the light on the flag fixed in front of city hall. Further discussion on the topic.

A motion was made by Trustee Phyllis Paro and seconded by Trustee Craig Boehmer to accept the budget for 2020.

All trustees voted in the affirmative and the motion carried to accept the 2020 budget.

Chief Jeff Dominguez explained the St Louis County Communication Contract. He explained what it was used for and that the price went up about \$500.00 a year. He also stated the department does not really have a choice of who to use. This includes the police radios, dispatching services, report services and many other items.

A motion was made by Trustee Craig Boehmer and seconded by Trustee Patricia Lewis approve the St Louis County Communications contract. Motion carried and the contract was accepted.

Trustees discussed closing City Hall early on Christmas Eve and letting the employees have the day off with pay. Further discussion on the topic. Trustee Steve Paro stated that city hall should have the whole day off with pay.

A motion was made by Trustee Phyllis Paro and seconded by Trustee Craig Boehmer to close City Hall on Christmas Eve for the whole day with pay.

A role call vote was made:


