Trustee Phyllis Paro stated that the complaints from the citizens on the new pricing of Republic Waste Management were researched and the following was found:

The cost of Republic Waste in other cities requires a \$50 pre-payment,
\$36 delivery fee for each container
Total cost is \$138.44 for three months

The cost in Riverview includes no pre-payment, no container fee and only \$91.86 for three months. Our village is much lower than many of Republics other clients.

Waste Management requires a \$100 pre-payment fee
\$132.97 for three months

NEW BUSINESS:

- A. A petition was submitted by a citizen to place speed bumps along Diamond Drive due to high traffic speed violations. Trustee Phyllis Paro stated that would not be appropriate for ambulance traffic as they would have to slow down when they may have a critical patient onboard. Other options were discussed such as chatter strips but those seemed inappropriate as well. Michael Lindgren, City Attorney, stated he will research different avenues to resolve the problem.
