

**SPECIAL OPEN MEETING MINUTES HELD BY
THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES
OF THE VILLAGE OF RIVERVIEW, ST. LOUIS COUNTY, MISSOURI,
HELD ON SEPTEMBER 27, 2018 6:15 p.m.**

BE IT REMEMBERED THAT the Board of Trustees of the Village of Riverview, St. Louis County, Missouri, met at City Hall, 9699 Lilac Drive at 6:15 pm on September 27, 2018.

At the time and place upon roll being called, there were found to be present the following named officers and members of the Board:

Village Clerk Sarah Jurgena and Village Attorney Chris Graville were also present.

As required by Missouri Law this meeting was set to discuss the 2018 tax levy. Village Attorney Chris Graville entered into the record the Special Open Meeting notice for the tax levy.

The meeting started with Attorney Chris Graville reading the new assessed valuations for residential property, commercial property and personal property. Next Attorney Graville read the new proposed tax rates for residential, commercial and personal property. Finally, he read the estimated tax revenue for residential, commercial and personal property.

He explained that the tax rates were set by St. Louis County. He also stated there will be an ordinance to pass for the tax levy in the board meeting following. This is the opportunity for the public and trustees to ask questions.

Citizen Patricia Lewis asked Attorney Graville how she can get her tax rate changed. He explained that she would have to personally call the county and file the request with them.


There was some discussion between the Trustees and the Village Attorney regarding other special taxes and the sewer lateral program.
